MEMBERSHIP OVERVIEW

The Board of the National Association of Women Business Owners establishes member classes. NAWBO Membership is open to individual business owners who own an equity interest and actively participate as a sole proprietor; an active partner of a partnership or active member of a limited liability company; and independent contractor; or individual owners of 5 percent or more of the stock of a corporation and who are involved in policy-making and day-to-day management of the corporation.

- NAWBO has chapters in most metropolitan areas. If there is a chapter within 45 miles of your home or business location, you must become a member of that chapter. If there is not a chapter in your area, you can join NAWBO national as an At-Large member.
- A NAWBO membership is recorded in the name of the individual, not the organization.
- A new member's join date is the first day of the month NAWBO National receives payment.
- Membership dues are nonrefundable and subject to change. A member may submit a written resignation to rescind her membership, but no portion of dues will be refunded.

AT-LARGE MEMBER (Voting) National membership only.

A business owner whose business and residence are not located within a Chapter's organization territory. A member in this classification has one (1) vote and is under the supervision of NAWBO. All voting members must belong to a chapter of NAWBO if one exists in their area.

EMERGING BUSINESS OWNER (Non-Voting)

For a new business owner (in business for two years or less). A non-voting category limited to two years, member receives all communications and publications, is eligible for all discounts and benefits, and is listed in the online member directory.

ESTABLISHED BUSINESS OWNER (Voting)

For a business owner who has been in business for more than two years. A regular voting category, member receives all communications and publications, is eligible for all discounts and benefits, and is listed in the online member directory. Chapter membership is automatic for those whose businesses are located in a chapter area. To qualify for membership, members must own a percentage of their company.

EMERITUS MEMBER (Voting)*

Shall be an individual who was a Chapter or At-Large member of NAWBO for at least five (5) years and has sold, divested their interest or is no longer operating their business. A member in this classification has one (1) vote. This category is NOT available online.

STUDENT MEMBER (Non-Voting)*

An individual who is a student registered full-time at a school or university, who subscribes to the objective of NAWBO and has interest in a future in entrepreneurship. This category is NOT available online; and any application submitted to the National office without chapter approval will be denied.

STUDENT MEMBER Chapter Only (Non-Voting)* *Same criteria as Student Member. Receives member rates for chapter events and selected benefits.

SUPPORTING MEMBER (Non-Voting)* An Individual who subscribes to the objectives of NAWBO and wishes to lend support to NAWBO through membership. *Membership applications in this category must be submitted directly to the chapter for approval.* This category is NOT available online; and any application submitted to the National office without chapter approval will be denied.

SUPPORTING EXECUTIVE (Non-Voting)* Same criteria as Supporting Member. Executives who wish to support NAWBO's mission. Recognized in newsletter and year long on Executive member page of NAWBO SFBA website.

SUSTAINING MEMBER (Voting)

For a business owner as defined in the NAWBO Policies and Procedures and is a Chapter member or an At-Large member who wishes to support the organization in a larger monetary way and gain additional benefits. A member in this classification has one (1) vote.

SUSTAINING MEMBER (Voting): Visionary*

Visionary members are current or retired business owners who commit to supporting the growth and sustainability of women business owners and show that commitment in their ongoing support for NAWBO SFBA. Visionary members are featured in our newsletter and throughout the year on a Visionary Member page on the website. Same criteria as Sustaining member.
